

Parking Summa College Eindhoven

Description

Around the buildings of Summa College there are various (free) parking facilities on its own grounds and in its immediate vicinity. For all private car parks it is only allowed to park in the designated parking spaces. Both the Security Department and the Facilities Department closely monitor this.

Explanation

There are various types of parking spaces on the site:

- 1- General parking spaces
- 2- Parking compartments for specific vehicles (mail vehicles, transport loading & unloading)
- 3- Parking spaces for visitors
- 4 Disabled parking spaces

Bicycle storage

Bicycles may only be parked in the designated parking spaces. The Facilities Department has the right to move, remove or chain bicycles that are not placed in the designated racks.

Disabled parking spaces

Disabled parking spaces are available to a limited extent on most parking spaces and may only be used by persons with a valid disabled parking dispensation. Should it appear that there is a need to expand these parking spaces, please contact the Facilities Department.

Specific vehicles

Parking spaces and loading and unloading areas for specific vehicles have been shaded on the car parks.

- These spaces can only be used by:
- a. Personnel Department Facilities
 - b. Suppliers/contractors

It is not permitted for students and staff to park their cars in these parking spaces.

Visitors

There are parking spaces for visitors in a number of car parks. Students and staff are not allowed to park their cars in these parking spaces. For questions about this, please contact the service point.

Responsibility

The Facilities Department is responsible for enforcing the parking policy and, if necessary, issues a warning note. The registration number is noted and registered. For each subsequent offence, the Facilities / Security Department will have the vehicle towed away.

If there is parking in places that can cause immediate danger to students and staff (e.g. emergency exits, etc.), the Facilities / Security Department will immediately proceed to have the car in question towed away.

In all cases the costs for this are for the offender.
